What are native plants?

Native plants are the species that grew in an area before humans began introducing plants to new places through colonization, global trade, and other processes. In North America, plants are generally considered native to an area if they grew there before European settlement disrupted thousands of years of land stewardship by Indigenous peoples.

These broad geographical and historical definitions are meant to exclude plant species introduced from other continents or some faraway state.

Why use native plants?

Native plants thrive because they are adapted to local soils and climates. Working *with* nature has many benefits:

- Native plants produce beautiful blooms and textures throughout the year while supporting pollinators (like bees and butterflies), birds, and other wildlife.
- Native plant communities produce deep roots that infiltrate rainwater and filter runoff naturally—better than any other system known to or made by humans.
- Established native plantings are generally easy and inexpensive to maintain. They grow year after year without fertilizers, pesticides, gas-powered lawn care equipment, or watering.



Why choose wild-type, local and regional genetic native plants and seed?

Wild-type, local genotype native plants and seed are as close as you can get to the wild native plant populations that have thrived in local habitat remnants for *thousands* of years.

Our wild-type native plants and seed originate from ethically hand-collected seed harvested from healthy wild populations in habitat remnants. These small quantities of seed are grown into hundreds of plants in our nurseries. The plants are then set into fields, producing a second generation of seed that we grow into tens of thousands of plants for further plant and seed production.

We focus on preserving and producing local genotypes because these strains of native plant species have adapted to the local area where they grow over many generations.

While *Panicum virgatum* (switch grass) is native to both Texas and Minnesota, that doesn't mean seed from switch grass adapted to soil and climate conditions in Texas will grow plants that can thrive in a Minnesota prairie—where conditions are very different. The opposite can also be true: A displaced genotype lacking the competition it evolved with may do *too well* and take over a site. Selecting a local genotype minimizes these issues.

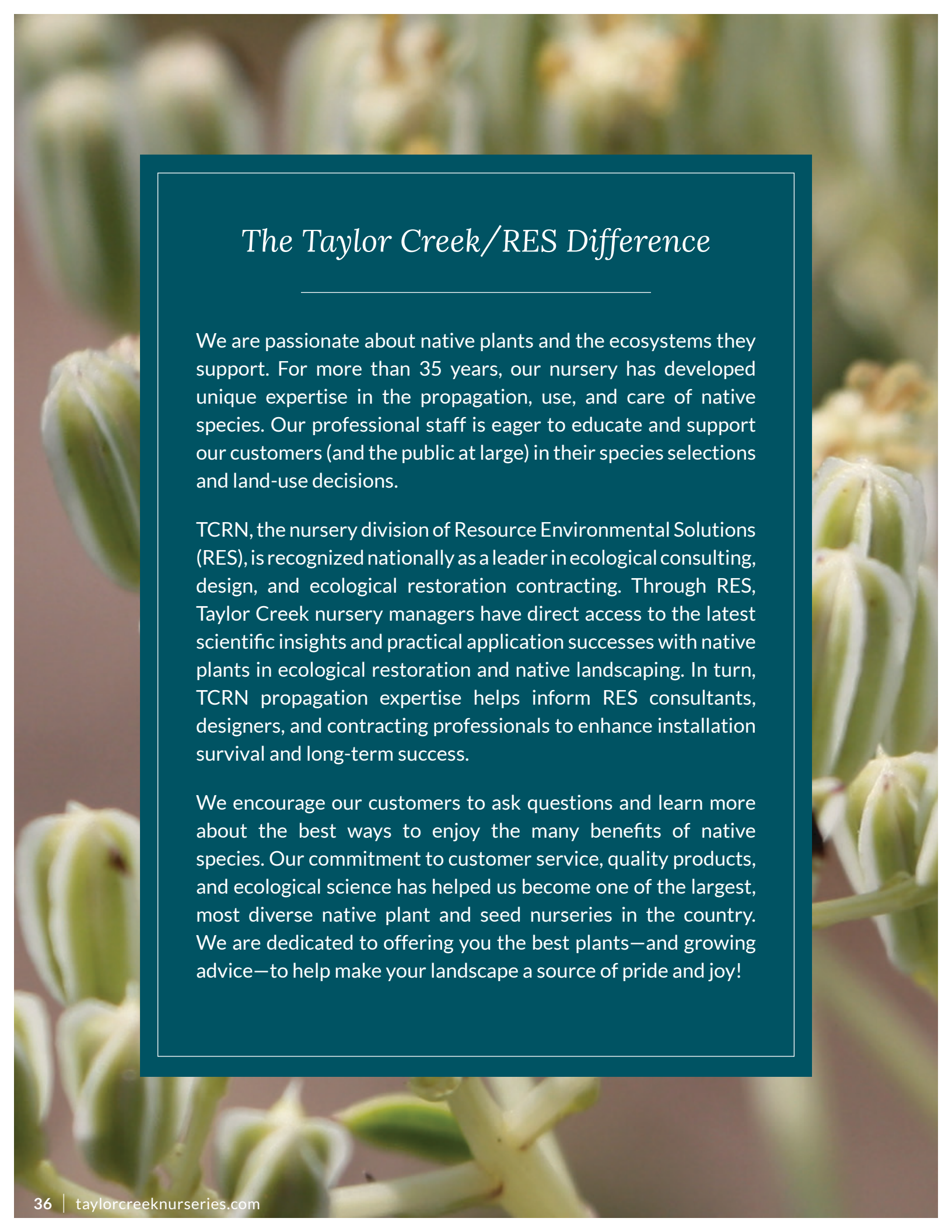
